


LARGE ITEM STICKER GUIDELINES

The Large Item Sticker is an option provided through the Gratiot Area Solid Waste Authority which enables the resident to purchase a sticker so they can place multiple large items out at the curb for disposal. As a resident of the City of Alma & the City of St. Louis you are permitted to place a single large item out each week on your regular collection day at no additional fee. This sticker will allow a resident to place out multiple items, if so desired, in a single week for the small fee of per sticker/item of \$15.00.

A single sticker must be used on each item and certain items do not quantify for this service.

Stickers are \$15 each and can be purchased at City Hall.



Stickers are non-refundable. If you have questions, please call City hall before using the sticker.

Acceptable Large Item Collection Includes the following:

Note: A single sticker must be affixed to each item and items must be placed curbside the night prior to collection.

Items That Will Not Be Collected:

- Any materials resulting from work performed by a commercial contractor
- Automobile parts including motors, tires on rims, doors, fenders, car seats, batteries, bumpers,
- Refrigerators, Freezers, Central air conditioning or heating units
- Ceramic tile Bricks Cinderblocks Chain link fencing
- Concrete Dirt Railroad ties Duct or sheet metal materials
- Fence posts with concrete attached Grocery carts Fire-damaged items
- Roofing materials, shingles Propane/oxygen tanks Sheetrock
- Yard waste Plaster Rocks Sand
- Nails or boards with protruding nails Marble or simulated marble countertops
- Floor coverings (except carpet/padding installed or removed by homeowner) Hot Tubs / Spa tubs
- Paint & other hazardous waste
