Residential Trash and Recycling Removal Guidelines

All residents within the city limits of St. Louis are entitled to utilizing city provided trash and recycling services. These services are contracted through Allied Waste Services and are provided on a weekly basis at the curbside. All materials to be collected must be out to the curb at 7 a.m. Houses located South of M-46 have Thursday collection and houses located North of M-46 have Friday collection.

The week of Memorial Day, 4th of July, Labor Day, Thanksgiving, Christmas, and New Years, trash collection will be one day late. If your regular collection is on Thursday, the trash will be collected on Friday and if your regular collection is on Friday, the trash will be collected on Saturday during those weeks.

Weekly Refuse Collection

Weekly collection includes all household trash contained in 32 gallon containers or trash bags which weigh less than 50 lbs. Also included in the weekly collection is one bulky item per week, (furniture, mattress, chair, etc.). Materials not contained in bags or containers must be bundled in 2 feet by 4 feet bundles and weigh less than 50 lbs.

Materials not accepted for collection include-Paint, Liquids, Yard Waste, Concrete, Roofing, Building or Demolition Materials, Dead Animals, and Tires.

Weekly Recycling Collection

All residents who are interested in weekly recycling collection can contact the city to receive a recycle bin to place material in for collection. (no charge).

Items accepted for collection include – Newspaper/Newsprint, Corrugated Cardboard (flattened and not to exceed 2feet by 4feet), Clear Glass, Paper Bags, Computer Paper and Office Paper, Tin and Aluminum Cans, # 1 and # 2 Plastics.

Items not accepted for recycle collection include – Scrap metal items, window glass, Ceramics, Styrofoam, Mirrors, Cookware, Oil containers, Medical items, light bulbs.
