Salaries/Per Diem Wages Discussion

Chairman Beeson requested that we start taking a harder look into Salary and Wages. Upon doing some comparisons of our County neighbor departments it is clear that we pay the least amount, which is embarrassing because we think we have the best department. While we understand that there is a volunteer aspect of the job, it shouldn't cost firefighters to respond to an event. We currently have a modern facility and updated equipment while being debt free.

The Fire Board discussed the local comparables and concluded that beginning with the Chief's position would be a good start and then consulting the chief for recommendations for other positions could happen and be revisited at the November meeting. Also, will consider any budget adjustments at that time.

Motion by Member Marr, supported by Member Giles to make the annual salary for the fire chief \$10,000 and reimbursement of both Fire and Rescue Runs be set to \$50 per run for that position beginning with the August pay.
