## Audience Recognition.

Karen Aumaugher, a resident of the city, informed the council of a neighbor burning trash in a firepit that they wrongfully built with patio blocks that belonged to her. Aumaugher stated the pit is very close to her home and is a fire hazard. She had had a conversation with the neighbor and they did say they would take care of the pit, but have failed to do so. Aumaugher made a complaint with the police department and has left several messages with the department and has heard nothing in return and it has been over two weeks. After she made the police report, she contacted Dori Foster, the city's Code Enforcer, but because she had already filed a police report, it was out of her hands and could not help with the matter. Sergeant Forshee asked that she stop into the department on Wednesday, and she would get her a copy of the police report that has been filed.

Dora Boody, a resident of the city, informed council of her disappointment in the lack of response from the police department.

Boody also informed council that she is upset that the city no longer shovels and maintains the sidewalks in her neighborhood, and she can no longer do it herself.

Max Clever of the Spicer Group updated council on the progress of the DWAM Project. Clever stated there were forty-two potential galvanized lines.

Chip has been working on preparing our summer equipment like the weed whip, chain saws, flail mower, street sweeper, and a few others. This is very important to have these pieces of equipment ready to operate when the time comes. I have found if we do our preventive maintenance out of season it allows us to take our time and do a sounder job and catch problems before they are problems and then we have less down time. The nice weather has also allowed us to start spring cleanup at the cemetery. This winter really took its toll on the trees in the cemetery, and we spent some time removing trees and bushes that fell or broke off. It never hurts to get a jump start on this kind of stuff when it's as bad as it was.



We've also been working on street signs and looking at what we have and don't have on the street and in the shop for replacements. This will allow us to order what we don't have and get it so that we will have it if our current ones fall or have already and need replaced.

Also, we have started working on some of the DWAM 2 valve potholes, we still have a lot to do yet so getting an early start was good for us. As you can see in the picture above, we operate with 4 guys and each man has a roll and job to do so we can be as efficient as we can be and complete as many valves as possible.

Our only seasonal left is Isaak and with help from Spicers he has been very busy gathering information and taking photos in house water lines. This is the 3<sup>rd</sup> and final step of our DWAM project.

As always, we have had to assist the water department a couple of times with water main breaks and water valves that needed repaired. With the nice weather we have been seeing a increase in yard waste bags on Mondays. The first week in March also found us doing brush which was more like a normal April. It's been a pretty steady month with the expectation of it to only get busier the further we get in the spring, and we look forward to it.

#### Notes on Expenditure Overages:

- A- Overage in City Manager Cost Center is due to the additional MERS contribution from Unfunded Pension Liability Funding policy that uses 6/30/2023 audit results. Budget amendments will be made. This will also effect the Police Fund as that contribution were between those two cost centers.
- B- Overage in Blight is for the expenditures related to the Grant received for the purchase and demo of 4 houses. There will be an increase of revenue as well in that budget amendment.
- C- Overage in Capital Outlay Public Works is due to the finish work on the Salt Shed build that was budgeted for in 22-23, hadn't anticipated it not being complete by year end. Budget amendment will be needed for that.
- D- MDOT Sweeping and Flushing overage is approved by MDOT. Likely amendment will be moving from other MDOT classifications or increasing their anticipated reimbursement to the City.
- E- Sidewalk work originally budgetted in Major Streets, moved work to Local Streets.
- F- DDA will be recommending budget amendments. They are required to expend accumulated funds within a certain timeframe, and its time but they were not aware of that at the time the budget was put together.

Revenue Overages are primarily in Interest, original estimates were made prior to rates increases.

# **Monthly Report**

#### February 2024 - March 2024

- Background prep and attending 2 City Council meetings.
- Continuing to assist OHM with information as the 2024 Water Main project moves ahead. Attending project update meetings, assisting with EGLE responses as well as service line and valve replacement information.
- Working with DPW and Spicer Group (Max) with the DWAM project due this summer to EGLE. DPW and Spicer completed interior house connection investigations. A few were not responsive so DPW will attempt to inspect those this summer. DPW will still be completing the field investigation of many of the valves. This is the "potholing" of the valve using the hydro-vac to identify the pipe materials in each side of the shut-off valve. Due to the weather, DPW personnel have been able to start some of the valve investigations already.
- Reviewing and assembling an updated Capital Improvement Plan for Water System with regards to the remaining replacements/upgrades as identified in our Water Reliability plan.
- Filed annual Air Quality reports with EGLE.
- Worked with MDOT (Kelly Bolt) regarding Act 51 mileage map and road classifications.
   Returned signed map to MDOT.
- Researched Pool Heater replacement with Kurt and Calvin for submittal to City Council.
- Met with Jacobs-EPA regarding their riverbank remediation project and interfacing with the City's Main Street Bridge Scour Protection Project (MDOT). Spicer expects to have our project in the December MDOT bid list for late summer 2025 construction.
- Monitored a water main break on Devon near Essex. Submitted photos to the City Manager once repair was completed.
- Reviewing completed information from DWAM project. Reviewing assessing
  information for dates of structures and inputting materials type for those selected
  addresses. From this information, I will be required to determine the "most likely" unselected addresses which could contain Lead/Galvanized private services for future
  investigations. This information will need to be filed with EGLE by October 2024.
- Attended a "Grant/Funding" webinar through MML regarding assistance in locating available grants.

#### **ADMINISTRATIVE WORK**

- Review time sheets weekly.
- Assist my departments with manpower and workload issues as they arise.
- Continuing to coordinate with DPW staff. Working closely with Calvin at DPW.
   Discussion items: DWAM project and investigation of curb valve locations and getting back to "pot-holing" the valves while weather is good, assistance on water main break, assist staff with house demolition project concerning sewer service investigations site cleanup by the contractor, pool heater replacement, seasonal staffing needs, budget needs, 2024 Paving/Maintenance program, met with contractor regarding possible repair to "problem" sanitary sewer line on Pine Street prior to possible re-paving, etc.
- Coordinate with Kurt, Bobbie, Mike, Phil, Calvin, and Rich on various issues.
- Review vendor billings and clarification of invoices.
- Review purchases with DPW, Electric, Water and WWTP staff.
- Review water purchase vs sewer treatment monthly to track I&I.
- Track water purchase vs water sold for loss calculations.
- Working with the Billing Clerk on invoices and sewer meter flows.
- Continuing to clean out computer and "hard copy" files.

#### Resident Calls/Issues:

North side of City experienced an electrical outage so Front office staff and I spent much of the morning addressing phone calls from residents.

#### **General Assistance:**

As Calvin was out on vacation, I coordinated with Alex, as needed for any issues at DPW. DWAM3 (home investigations) personnel met with me daily to review their progress and inform me of any issues they were having.

#### Miscellaneous:

#### Departments:

**DPW:** Continuing to work on DWAM Phase 3 water service lead identification project (internal plumbing investigation). Delivery date is October 2024. Personnel have been working on equipment maintenance and repairs for the upcoming spring/summer seasons. MISSDIG utility locating is still regularly active. Personnel assisted the Water Dept with the Devon water main break and various valve replacements and service line investigations. Work at the Cemetery has begun with the cleaning up of many of the heavy branches downed over the winter. Regular bag and brush pick up continues as scheduled. Work has begun on the removal of the old pool heater in preparation for the installation of the new one.

Water Department: Performed a repair on a water main break on Devon at Essex. Replacing meters, performing shut offs and turn-ons of water service, and MISS DIG staking. Busy opening and closing graves for funerals.

**Electric Department:** Continuing with tree clearing and line maintenance. Addressed a recent power outage and two personal vehicle accidents which hit two of the city streetlights.

This will the 2024 Spring paving project and this has a lot of pieces and steps that will need to be complete in order so that our streets will continue to improve and last a long time.

With the Pine st and Center st reconstruction plan not getting approved last spring, we had to look at alternative repairs for Pine st sewer. We have received two bids to repair the sewer, one from Dice Exc. and the other from Ward Exc. I recommend that we go with Ward Exc. for \$112,399. With Ward's being able to start earlier this spring, it helps our timeline. After we repair the sewer, we can repave it and Central Asphalt gave us a bid of \$115,541 to pulverize and to put two layers of asphalt down. With the repairing of the sewer on Pine St we need to do a sealing of the interior of the manhole at Center and Pine for a cost of \$270 per linear foot. To be able to get this price we had to have enough for them to come up. So, I chose 42 ft total, to repair at a total cost of \$11,340 from Advanced Rehabilitation Technology. This will help us make our manholes last a long time and this comes with a 10 year warranty. The lining of our manholes is something that we have been doing for several years now and are having good luck with.

Then we have S. East St and the small section of Hazel St (behind the library) to pulverize and pave. Central Asphalt gave us a bid of \$178,546 to complete both streets. These streets are heavily traveled and in poor shape.

With us repaving these streets, we will need to make repairs to the storm and sewer structures to make the street smooth and last as long as we can. I have received a quote from East Jordan for \$9,722 to purchase the frames and covers we need.

Next is our preventive maintenance and with the success of the GSB 88 we are recommending this treatment again. Following is a list of the streets with a total of \$72,100.

W. State st
Maple St
Mill St (46 to Prospect minus the bridge)
Prospect St (Main to Corinth)
Corinth St (Prospect to Olive)
Devon Dr.

The last part of this project is the adjustment of the structures in our new asphalt. We had Crawford Contracting give us a quote on adjusting and installing our new manhole structures. When they gave us the quote, we started to do some research and found for a little bit more we could purchase the machine and do it ourselves. We expect that around 25 MH structures pays for the unit and this project has 16. I recommend that we purchase a Manhole Core machine up to \$50,000. This will allow us to be more efficient at repairing our structure in the future and with the new water main work coming next summer this will be very beneficial.

I know that this all sounds very confusing but if you look at the spread sheet (in your project packet) it breaks it all down and helps to see what is happening and where. You will also see a map of the streets that we will be working on. These repairs will really help our streets to last longer and there are a lot of pieces to it and every piece helps the other.

This entire project is in our budget plan for 2023/2024 Pine St is under Majors St and Hazel and East are under local streets. These totals would put the final number at \$549,648.00.

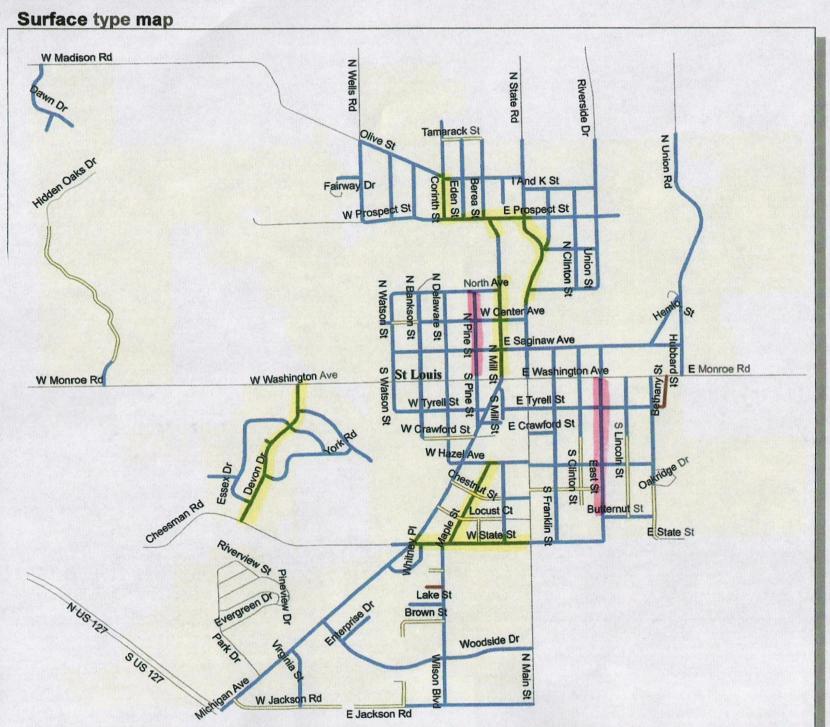

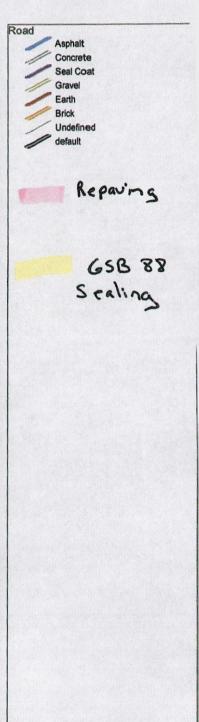
