Minutes.

Moved by Member Giles, supported by Member Bajena, to approve the minutes of August 8, 2023 meeting. All ayes carried the motion.

Claims and Accounts.

The Fire Board reviewed the Claims & Accounts.

Moved by Member Giles, supported by Member Mikek, to approve the Claims & Accounts for August 1, 2023 to October 31, 2023 in the amount of \$124,034.03. All ayes carried the motion.

Financial Statements.

The Fire Board reviewed and discussed the Financial Statements of October 31, 2023, and placed on file.

Fire Chief's Report.

The Fire Chief's Report was reviewed, discussed, and placed on file.

Request to use Training Reserved funds

Past funds reserved for training have accumulated to \$10,879. These funds were for amounts made on training in excess of the cost of the programs that our department were putting on for others. Currently the County/State have made such training programs more accessible so our department has not been hosting those programs. The department has a goal of building a

smoke/fire training facility and has programed in over 3 budget years. Chief Coty has requested that the training funds be applied to this project so that it can be completed within the year rather than in small increments.

Motion by Member Marr, supported by Member Bajena to use Training Reserved Funds for the implementation of the training facility. All ayes carried the motion.

Define/clarify run classification definition of Roadway Incidents.

Discussed the medical and fire incidents on roadways and need to more specifically define them.

Motion by Member Mikek, supported by Member Giles to classify all roadway incidents as mutual aid incidents, with all Member Units sharing in those costs equally regardless where they geographically occur. All ayes carried the motion.

Proposed Pay Rate Recommendation

To continue the discussion on pay rates, Chief Coty brought a recommended Pay Rate proposal that he and the other officers had worked on. Discussion of the proposal was held.

Motion by Member Marr, supported by Member Mikek, to change the pay structure for firefighters as follows:

Effective immediately (payable on November runs – December check)

• Run rate for probationary Firefighters will increase to \$20/run

Effective with the calendar year end of 2023 (payable January 2024)

• There will be a \$500 incentive payment for all employees meeting the 40% Run, 70% Training criteria for the year.

Effective with runs/work beginning in January 2024 (first check payable February 2024)
