DDA Façade Grant Program

Moved by Coty, supported by Nannan to approve the removal of front, side, and rear façade distinctions, shift the grant onto the fiscal calendar, and increase the available amount to \$3,000. Five grant opportunities for a total of \$15,000 were approved for 2025. All Ayes/Motion Carried.

The Board discussed possible changes to the façade grant before approving the motion. All agreed that the program continues to be beneficial and that increasing the amount will help cover rising costs.

Motion by Giles, supported by Coty for the use of Powder Coating of Central MI to sandblast and powder coat nine benches along M-46.

Motion by Bailey, supported by Lewis to approve the purchase of nine commercial steel waste receptacles, to replace those along M-46, and one picnic table, for placement near St. Louis Optics.

Planning for 2025 – Board reviewed some items that came up at the November 7 meeting:

Ended investigation into painting the fire hydrants and placing a bench near the SHOP, Huntington installed a bench near the bank.

Discussed the Old Bank building and possibilities for the DDA to assist the City financially.
