- d. Dominique Adams, Pool Director has been contacted by National Fitness Campaign regarding using the pool area for their program. Dominique

went over the hand out and showed a video of what they do. Discussion. Craig Zeese is willing to contact other Cities about how this is working in their Community. He will then report back at next Park & Rec meeting.

Phil Hansen talked about the 5 Year Plan and is trying to get information together and present at a future Meeting. Some items will be farmer's Market Pavillion; Sineage in the Parks; Community Ed Program; Little Leagues; School Projects and the Lot on the corner of West Washington Street, formerly Tony's Restaurant; All War's Memorial Park discussion; Clapp Park, get MDOT to designate Geographical Center of Michigan Historical Society; and the Healthy Pine River.
