Resolution 2019-03 - Approval of St. Louis Area Fire Department to Participate in the Gratiot Community Mutual Aid Box Alarm System Division

The following preamble and resolution were offered by Member Marr, and supported by Member Bajena:

WHEREAS, the Mid-Michigan Community Fire Control Board a.k.a. St. Louis Area Fire Department has the power, privilege and authority to maintain and operate a fire department providing fire protection, fire suppression, emergency medical services, technical rescue, hazardous incident response, and other emergency response services ("Fire Services"); and

WHEREAS, Fire Services can further be improved by cooperation between political subdivisions during times of public emergency, conflagration or disaster ("Incidents"); and

**WHEREAS**, the Michigan Constitution of 1963, Article 7, 28, and the Urban Cooperation Act of 1967, Act No. 7 of the Public Acts of 1967, Ex. Sess., being MCL 124.501 et seq. (the "Act"), permit a political subdivision to exercise jointly with any other political subdivision any power, privilege or authority which such political subdivisions share in common and which each might exercise separately; and

**WHEREAS**, the Mid-Michigan Community Fire Control Board desires to enter into an interlocal agreement, pursuant to the Act, to further improve Fire Services; and

**WHEREAS**, the Mutual Aid Box Alarm System (MABAS), is a mechanism that may be used for deploying personnel and equipment in a multi-jurisdictional or multi-agency emergency mutual aid response; and

WHEREAS, as a result of entering into an interlocal agreement to further improve Fire Services, the Parties are creating the Gratiot County MABAS Division; and

**WHEREAS**, Mid-Michigan Community Fire Control Board has the authority to execute this Agreement pursuant to resolution of its governing body; and

WHEREAS, Mid-Michigan Community Fire Control Board desires to commit personnel and equipment to another Party if deemed reasonable upon the request of another Party; and

**NOW, THERFORE BE IT RESOLVED**: The Mid-Michigan Community Fire Control Board a.k.a. St. Louis Area Fire Department finds it is the best interest of its citizens from a safety and fiscal standpoint to enter into the Interlocal Agreement creating the Gratiot County MABAS Division.

Position: Fire Chief

THIS JOB REPORTS TO: SLAFD Fire Board

**JOB SUMMARY:** The Fire Chief shall be the Chief Executive Officer of the fire department and will be responsible to the SLAFD Fire Board. Under the general authority of the SLAFD Fire Board, the Fire Chief shall be responsible for the administration and operation of the fire department.

The Fire Chief will plan, organize, direct, and administer all operations of the fire department including fire suppression, rescue, fire investigation, fire prevention, medical first responders. Other duties will include the management of fire department personnel, supplies, equipment, and structures.

The SLAFD Fire Board will entrust the administration and operation of the fire department to the Fire Chief, and the Fire Chief will serve at the pleasure of the Fire Board.

# **DUTIES AND RESPONSIBILITIES:**

- 1. The Fire Chief shall be the Chief Executive Officer (CEO) responsible to the SLAFD Board for the proper administration and efficient operation of the department.
- 2. The Chief is the executive head of the Fire Department and shall have full charge of the protection of life and property and the extinguishment of fires and providing emergency medical services.
- 3. Assigns officers to administer the work of the department and holds them responsible for the proper execution of their duties.
- 4. Responsible for enforcing the rules, regulations, and orders of the SLAFD Board pertaining to the Fire Department and the laws of the State of Michigan applicable to the department.
- 5. Develops policies designed to maintain or increase the general efficiency and effectiveness of the department, including planning and critiquing of fires, planning for departmental long-range needs, regulation and assignment of personnel and management of the department in order to be prepared to meet emergencies.
- 6. The Fire Chief shall schedule regular meetings with firefighters for informational and training purposes.
- 7. The Fire Chief has authority to make expenditures according to general Board policy.
- 8. May review plans and specifications submitted for new construction, remodeling, and alterations for conformity to fire codes, ordinances, and laws to the best of the Chief's ability.
- 9. The Fire Chief is empowered to enter and make inspections of buildings, structures and premises and to serve written notice upon the owners or occupant to abate, within a specified time, all fire hazards that may be found.
- 10. Plans, coordinates, and supervises all activities of the Fire Department.
- 11. Provides supervision and direction to all department officers.
- 12. May assign other officers of the Fire Department to administer functions, projects, or programs as necessary.

- 13. Develops, administers, and oversees appropriate training programs. Designates personnel to carry out the training.
- 14. Ensures that the Fire Department is adequately staffed for effective operations including fire prevention, fire suppression, and for life-saving services. Designates personnel to assist with the recruitment and vetting of potential firefighters.
- 15. Ensures that all firefighting vehicles, equipment, apparatus, and facilities are properly maintained in operating condition and that all equipment maintenance records are kept on file and up-to-date. Designates personnel to assist in the maintenance program of vehicles, equipment, apparatus, and facilities.
- 16. Prepares an annual budget for review and approval of the SLAFD Board.
- 17. Monitors the budget to assure expenditures remain within budget.
- 18. Processes billing invoices and purchases equipment according to departmental needs
- 19. Ensures timely and proper reporting of events as required by the State of Michigan. Designates personnel to assist with data entry.
- 20. Prepares a variety of reports for the SLAFD Board, state agencies, and others regarding departmental activities.
- 21. Works with other fire chiefs, police agencies, EMS, hospitals, and other public agencies to encourage fire protection cooperation.
- 22. Answers questions raised by citizens of the Fire District regarding services or related topics.
- 23. Performs all the duties of a firefighter and operates all fire suppression equipment. Provides departmental fire service and medical first responder coverage as needed.
- 24. Attends various classes and seminars to remain current and knowledgeable in fire suppression and rescue techniques.

# KNOWLEDGE, SKILLS, AND ABILITIES:

- 1. EDUCATION: High school graduate or equivalent plus necessary firefighting and office training courses.
- 2. EXPERIENCE: Three to five years progressively responsible firefighting with supervisory, budgeting, and personnel relations experience.
