<u>Financial Report:</u> The reports were reviewed and there was a discussion of budgets and upcoming millage vote.

<u>Statistical Report</u>: Jessica reported that all statistics were below average due to pandemic orders, with the exception of wi-fi usage.

Old Business: The library has received the furniture custom-made by the Shark Wood Shop, with many thanks and much appreciation. The open position on the board will be advertised in the city newsletter and Jessica is also considering using social media to help in the search.

New Business: There was discussion of the viability of the library hosting the Volunteer Income Tax Assistance program while under pandemic orders. The 2021 schedule for filing taxes has been adjusted by the IRS. Options for online assistance are also being explored.

Microfiche from the Gratiot County Herald covering the years 1931-1937 have been found and the library system is looking into the possibility of a group project to share the costs and make copies available at each library.

The new Hotspot User Agreement and the Laptop User Agreement were both reviewed by the board. Michelle Kelly made a motion to approve both as library policy; the motion was supported by Theresa Jewell; motion passed.
